Information notice under Art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter also referred to as GDPR, and legislative decree no. 196/2003 (including subsequent amendments and additions)

**DATA CONTROLLER -** The processing of personal data by the IMT School for Advanced Studies Lucca (hereinafter referred to as "School") is based on the principles provided by art. 5 of EU Regulation 2016/679. The Data Controller is the School, represented by the pro-tempore Rector, registered office in Piazza San Ponziano, 6, 55100 Lucca, certified email: imtlucca@postecert.it.

CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA, PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING - Personal data (identification and contact data, any participants portrait photo, video or other audiovisual material) will be processed under Art. 6(1)(a), of the Regulation, only for purposes strictly related to the institutional activities of the School, such as teaching and orientation, research, transfer of scientific and technological knowledge (third mission). The provision of personal data is optional, but not providing them will result in exclusion from the registration of images (photos) / audio-video recordings.

**CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS AND POTENTIAL TRANSFERRING OF DATA -** Processed data can only be accessed by employees and collaborators of the competent School Offices. These subjects will be authorized and duly qualified to this end, also with regard to compliance with security measures and confidentiality obligations. Data may be communicated to third parties and disclosed in accordance with the consent release form and the information notice provided herein. The Data Controller may also use entities qualified for the aforementioned processing, who will process the data as Data Processors under Art. 28 of the Regulation.

**PROCESSING METHOD AND PERSONAL DATA RETENTION TIME -** Personal data will be stored in the School's computer and/or paper archive for the time necessary to carry out the purposes for which they were collected, in accordance with the retention time provided for by current regulations, or in any case.

**RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT AND EXERCISE OF THE SAME -** The interested party has the right to withdraw consent for processing of their personal data at any time by sending an email to <a href="mailto:affarigenerali@imtlucca.it">affarigenerali@imtlucca.it</a>. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent provided before the withdrawal. The interested party is entitled to exercise the rights indicated in sections 2, 3, and 4 of Chapter III of the GDPR, where applicable to the specific treatment. The interested party has the right to file a complaint with the Data Protection Authority if they believe that the processing of their personal data violates the GDPR, under the terms and conditions of art. 77 of said Regulation.
